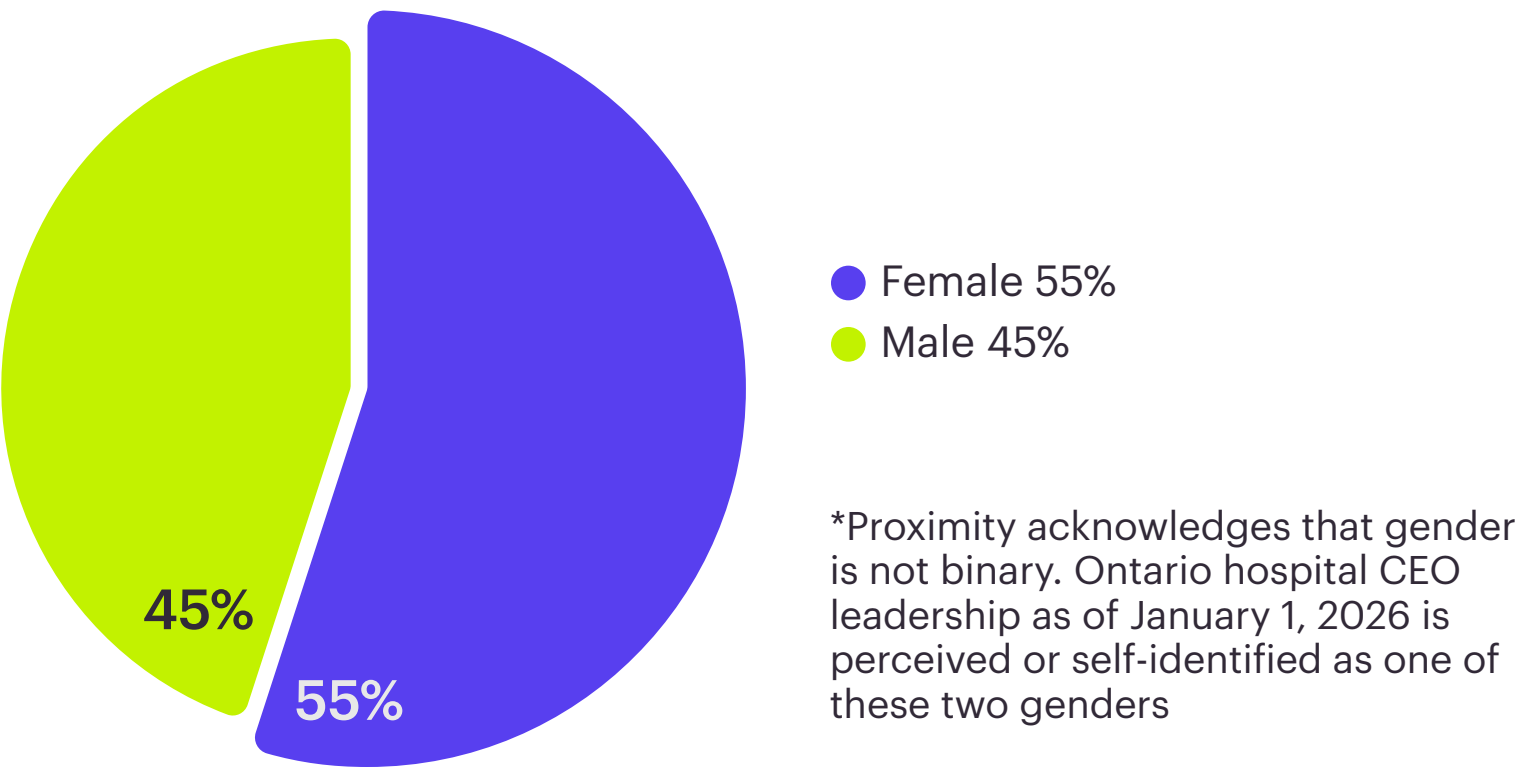


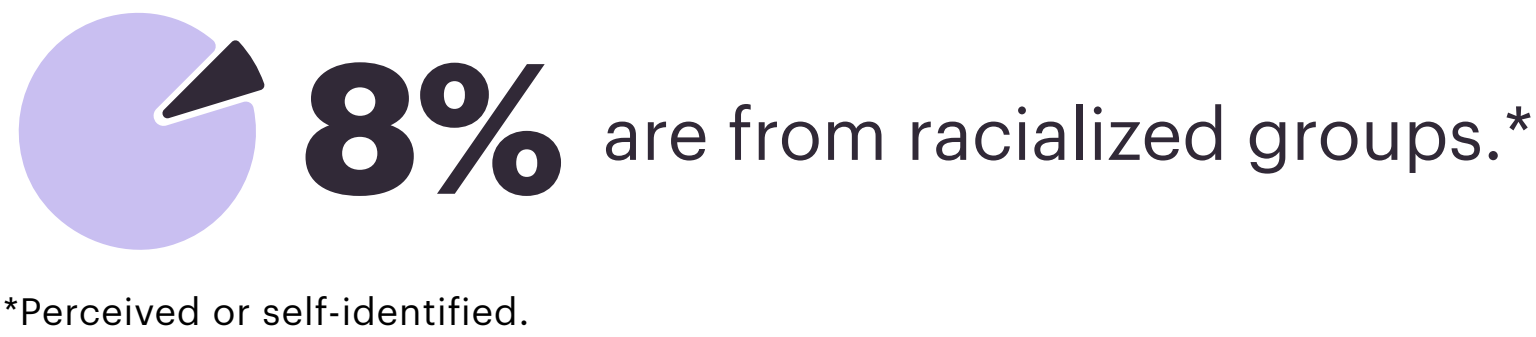

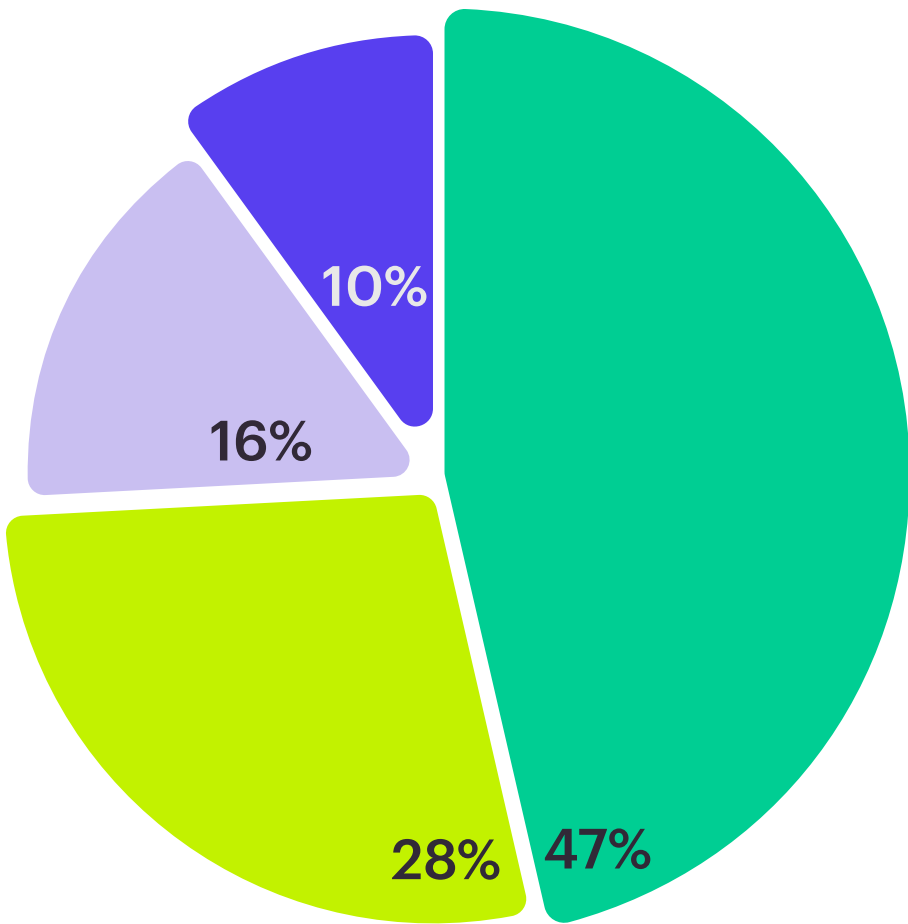


**The average age is 57.**

- Physicians 10%



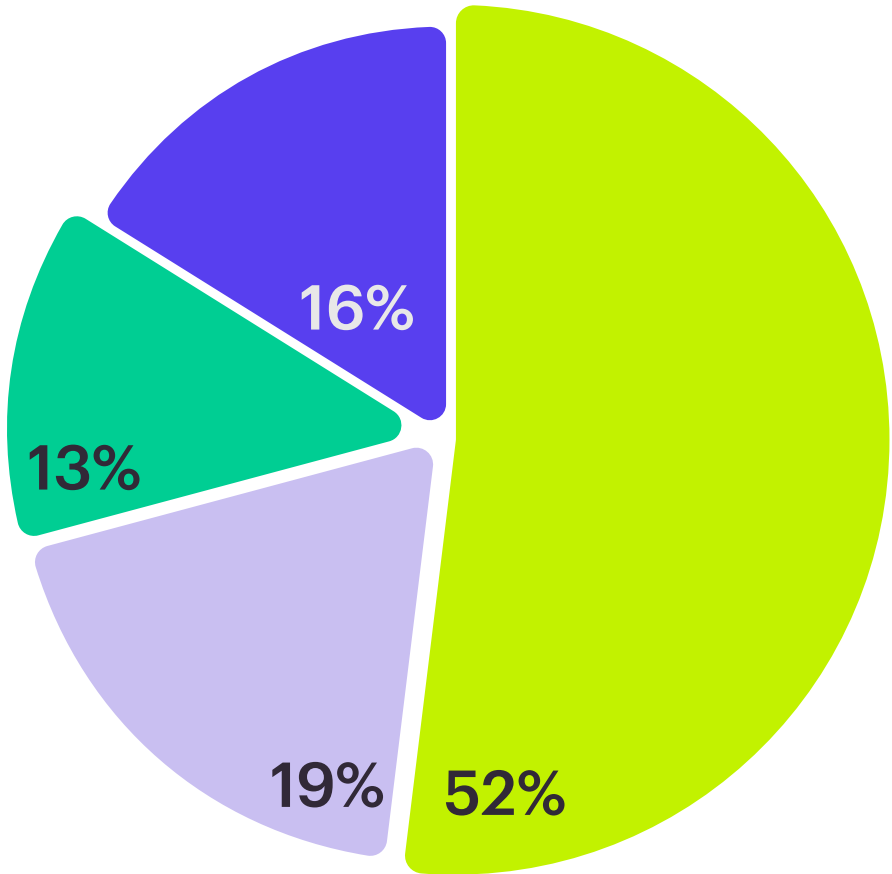
Current Ontario hospital Presidents and CEOs have been in the role for **5.2** years on average

Presidents and CEOs are recruited from four sources

- Within the hospital 52%
- Another Ontario hospital, prior CEO appointment 19%
- Another Ontario hospital, no prior CEO appointment 13%
- Outside of Ontario hospital sector 16%
